Check-In: Check-in starts at 3pm October 19th

Check-Out: Check-out is at 10am October 21st

Meals: Each family is responsible for their own meals. All are encouraged to pool their resources and cook in groups or conduct potluck meals.

Alcohol: In keeping with the policy of the YMCA Adventure Guides program **PLEASE, NO ALCOHOL!**

Campsites: Site assignments are made that weekend. Please see YMCA Staff upon arrival.

Camp Fires: Allowed in provided fire pit only, please bring your own firewood.

Driving/Parking: Please obey the posted speed limit on all camp roads and areas. Regulations are strictly enforced. You may be assigned a parking space away from your campsite.

Kid Safety: Parents please set boundaries and safety guidelines for your children prior to camp.

Quiet Hours: Quiet Hours are from 10:00pm until 8:00am. Radios, TV's, and generators must be off between the hours of 8:00pm and 9am. Radio noise must be limited to the immediate area of your campsite.
